



Café Supervisor Vacancy

Our community café, Hobson's Café, opened two days a week in September 2015 and since then has progressed to opening 4 days a week. We are now aiming to open a further 2 days a week and need a creative cook to help manage our volunteers and create our "specials".

The café is currently managed by a part time manager and staffed by volunteers.

We bake all of our cakes, quiches, stews, soups etc. so we need someone who is confident in creating dishes from the ingredients that we have in, has experience of working with volunteers, good organisational skills and has experience of working/volunteering in a café environment. The Café Supervisor will be a key role in providing a warm welcome and fantastic customer service to all users of the building and the general public.

The position is for **12.5 hours per week on a Friday and Saturday** approx. 8.30-2.30 p.m. during term time. Some flexibility may be required according to business needs.

The rate of pay will be **£8.70 per hour**. An immediate start is possible (subject to satisfactory references).
